

OFFICIAL NOTICE

2019 STORM WATER DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT VILLAGE OF FOX POINT, WISCONSIN

OWNER/TIME: The Village of Fox Point will accept sealed bids **until 11:00 A.M. on Tuesday, February 5, 2019 at the office of the Director of Public Works**, Village of Fox Point, 7200 N. Santa Monica Boulevard, Fox Point, Wisconsin 53217. At that time, Village officials will publicly open and read the Bids for the furnishing of all materials and the performance of the work as described below, in accordance with the Contract Documents (CD).

Project location in the vicinity of:

1. Intersection of E. Spooner Road and N. Santa Monica Blvd.
2. Intersection of E. Green Tree Road and N. Lake Drive.

The work associated with 2019 Storm Water Drainage Improvement Project includes the following estimated quantities:

BASE BID:

Intersection of E. Spooner Road and N. Santa Monica Blvd.:

- Mill and remove 4-inch asphalt surface – approximately 380 SY
- HMA pavement approximately 100 Ton
- Installation of approximately 40 feet of 3x9- foot precast concrete box culvert
- Cast-in-place concrete stamped (form liner) headwalls and concrete pads
- Relay of approximately 100 L.F. of 6-inch PVC water main by open-cut trench installation
- Installation of approximately 20 L.F. of 16-inch steel casing pipe (in trench)

Intersection of E. Green Tree Road and N. Lake Drive:

- Cast-in-place reinforced concrete wall
- Heavy Rip-Rap of approximately 100 TON
- Landscaping restoration within the project limits - approximately 800 SY

ALTERNATE BID 1 - 8308 N. Santa Monica Blvd.:

- Cast-in-place reinforced concrete headwall
- 24" Nyloplast drain basin and 15" inline drain

ALTERNATE BID 2 - Intersection of E. Spooner Road and N. Santa Monica Blvd.

- Installation of approximately 80 L.F. (40 L.F.x2) of 38"x 60" precast concrete elliptical cross culvert (Intersection of E. Spooner Road and N. Santa Monica Blvd.).

WALK-THROUGH: The Village and Kapur & Associates, Inc. will conduct only one pre-bidding walk-thru/site visit to verify the existing site condition. The walk-through is scheduled for **Monday, January 28, 2019 at 10:30 A.M.** Contractors shall meet at the intersection of E. Spooner Road and N. Santa Monica Blvd.

Each bid proposal must be submitted on the bid/proposal form provided in the CD and shall be enclosed in a sealed envelope addressed to the Village of Fox Point and marked "Bid" with the project name. Bidders should pay particular attention to the requirements for Bid signatures, as set forth in paragraph 06 of the Instructions to Bidders.

As a part of their Bid, Bidders shall submit a full and complete list of: 1) all of the proposed Subcontractors and 2) the class of work which each will perform. Failure to include the Subcontractor list will be cause for rejection of a Bid. The selected Contractor shall not alter this list without the written consent of the Director of Public Works. A Contractor's Qualification Statement is also required and should be submitted with the Bid if not previously submitted. The CDs require that the selected Contractor furnish a Certificate of Insurance and Payment and Performance Bonds issued in the amount of the bid.

AWARD DATE: Anticipated award date is **February 12, 2019**. The selected Contractor may begin work only after the Village has issued him a Notice to Proceed. The anticipated project start date is **April 2019**. The selected Contractor must complete all work Not Later Than **120** days after the date of issuance of the Notice to Proceed.

BID GUARANTEE: Only those bids that are accompanied by a Bid Bond or unqualified certified check in an amount not less than five percent (5%) of the bid will be considered. The Bid Bond or certified check serves as a guarantee that if the bid is accepted, the bidder will execute and file the Agreement and a 100% Performance Bond and Payment Bond within fifteen (15) days after the Notice of Award. In case the bidder fails to file such contract and bond within the time set forth, the certified check or Bid Bond shall be forfeited as liquidated damages.

STATUTORY PROVISIONS: The contract letting shall be subject to the provisions of the Wisconsin Statutes, including Section 61.55, 61.56, 62.15, 66.0901, 66.0903, 779.14 and 779.16.

BID WITHDRAWAL: No bid shall be withdrawn for a period one hundred twenty (120) days after the bid opening date without the consent of the Village of Fox Point.

BID REJECTION: The Village of Fox Point reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to accept any bid most advantageous to it, or waive any technicality.
