Re: 2019 Road Reconstruction Project – Public Information Meeting
Calumet Road and Bergen Drive

Dear Resident:

I am writing to inform you that the Village will hold a **Public Information Meeting (PIM) on Thursday, March 28, 2019 at 6:00 pm in the Board Room (Schwemer Room) at the Village Hall (7200 North Santa Monica Boulevard)**. At the meeting, staff, Kapur & Associates (the Village's consultant), Wood Sewer & Excavating (the Village's contractor) and WE Energies will explain the project, limits of construction, project duration, detours and other related construction matters and will be available to answer questions. The PIM is expected to last about 1 hour. After the meeting, staff will post the presentation on the Village website, FAQs and, as the project progresses, status updates.

As some of you may have already noticed, KS Energy has mobilized to Calumet Road and will begin installation of new gas main and laterals the week of March 25th. Their work, being performed for WE Energies, is expected to be completed within approximately six weeks of the start of construction. Our contractor, Wood Sewer & Excavating, is planning to start work on Calumet Road on or about April 15th and will work Monday through Thursday from 7:00 am to 7:00 pm (weather dependent).

Prior to the start of construction by Wood Sewer & Excavating, we are requesting residents inform us whether (a) you have your downspouts or sump pump discharging directly to the ditch in front of the house and (b) you have an invisible fence located within the Village Right of Way. Please fill out the attached form and bring it with you to the PIM or return it to my attention prior to April 1. Please note that while invisible fences are not permitted within the Right of Way, efforts will be made to avoid them where possible and repair them if we have prior notice of the location of the fence prior to the start of construction. Absent prior notification, the Village nor Wood Sewer & Excavating can make any assurances that a damaged invisible fence will be repaired.

Along with Village staff, our contractor and consultant will work to keep any inconvenience to a minimum in order to complete this project in a timely and professional manner. Feel free to contact me at (414) 351-8900 with any questions that you might have about the upcoming work.
