Re: **Beach Drive Coastal Resiliency Public Information Meeting**

Dear Resident:

I am writing to inform you that the Village will hold a **Public Information Meeting (PIM) on Tuesday, April 25, 2023 at 6:00 pm**. The meeting will be held in person in the Board Room (2nd Floor) of Village Hall at 7200 North Santa Monica Boulevard. However, we will also provide residents with the opportunity to participate in the PIM via Zoom rather than in person (login information is at the bottom of this letter).

While some work has begun, the purpose of the PIM is to provide updates on the project schedule and planned activities to be performed during the course of the next four to six months. Prior to the meeting, residents are encouraged to visit the Village website (<https://www.villageoffoxpoint.com/631/Beach-Drive-Coastal-Resiliency-Project>) to refamiliarize themselves with the information presented in 2021 and 2022. The design reflects the results of conversations with the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources and the Army Corps of Engineers.

Once prompted, click on “Open Zoom Meetings.” The Meeting ID (899 1065 3181) will appear at login. Two windows will appear – one asking you to choose one of the audio conference options (explained below) and the other showing the Meeting Topic, Host and other information.

For those of you using a laptop, iPad, or other handheld device, you will likely just need to select “Computer Audio” to access the meeting and have the ability to hear the presentation and ask questions. If you are using a desktop computer with no video camera and/or audio capabilities, you will need to select the “Phone Call” option to call into the meeting using the following number:

You will then need to enter the Meeting ID (899 1065 3181) and hit the # key. You may be asked for a participant ID which should appear on your screen when you enter the link above. You can enter that ID and the # key as prompted.

Please note that due to previous problems with Zoom meetings, this meeting will be run as a webinar. While you will not be able to type in questions in a chat box during the webinar, you will be able to raise your hand which will allow staff to grant you the ability to verbally pose your question.
